## **Draft Recommendations | CONNECT**

- > Removal of vehicle travel lane on Chestnut Street west of 34<sup>th</sup> Street in favor of eastbound buffered bike lane.
- > Road diet on 38<sup>th</sup> Street north of Market Street and pedestrian amenities south

    - > Elevators for accessibility




